

ST. LOUIS C/O '87 FALLEN BROTHERS MEMORIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT FORMAT & RULES

1. 4- Person scramble – All four (4) players on the team will hit off the tee. After selecting one ball, the players will hit the next shot from there and so fourth until the ball is holed.
2. Scoring – Team captains will keep scorecards and record scores of their own teams and only the team score shall be recorded. Put the total amount of strokes.
3. Tee shots – Minimum four (4) drives per player must be used. Men – white tees and women – red tees.
4. In order to speed up play, team swill hit when ready and pick up after a triple bogey. Max is triple bogey per hole.
5. Winter rules – balls can be moved within one club length (free) except from hazards.
6. Putting – max 2 putts per green.
7. **Par 3 holes**
 - a. On green par 3 holes - # 3, 6, 12, 16 will be for individuals landing and staying on the green.
 - b. Off the green par 3 holes - will be for individuals landing and staying off the green. **(The prizes for the holes were donated by St. Louis c/o '87).**
 - c. Hole in One
8. **Fairway Contest**
 - a. **Long drive** – hole #13 must be in the fairway. Please write your name on all markers.
 - b. **Accurate drive** - hole #15 must be closest to the line. Please write your name on all markers.
9. **Hole one tie breaker** – if multiple players get a hole in one on the same hole then the player who did it first, and is verified, will win the prize.
10. **Long drive tie breaker** – if multiple players have same distance in the fairway, then the players will split the purse evenly.
11. **Accurate drive tie breaker** – if multiple players have same distance from the line, then the players will split the purse evenly.
